TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AGREEMENT

1. PURPOSE

This Agreement sets forth the terms under which the Company will provide transportation services for the minor child(ren) listed below.

2. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Company will provide transportation services for the above-named child(ren) between designated pick-up and drop-off locations, on dates and times agreed upon in advance with the Parent/Guardian.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

Parent/Guardian acknowledges that transportation inherently involves risks, including but not limited to vehicular accidents, injury, illness, and unforeseeable incidents.

Parent/Guardian hereby releases, waives, and holds harmless the Company, its owners, employees, drivers, agents, and contractors from any and all claims, damages, or liabilities arising from participation in the transportation service, except where prohibited by law.

4. ASSUMPTION OF RISK

4.1 They have evaluated the risks involved in allowing their child to use the Company's transportation services.

4.2 They accept full and complete responsibility for any injury, harm, loss, or damage that may occur to their child during transportation, including harm caused by other passengers or third parties, except where prohibited by law.

4.3 They understand that no background check or screening process can guarantee the prevention of misconduct, and they accept that risk knowingly and voluntarily.

5. ABUSE AND MISCONDUCT PREVENTION DISCLOSURE

5.1 Zero-Tolerance Policy: The Company maintains a zero-tolerance policy for any form of abuse,

molestation, neglect, or inappropriate conduct toward minors.

5.2 Background Checks: All drivers and staff are required to undergo background checks to the extent permitted by law.

5.3 Supervision Practices: Staff are instructed to avoid situations where a child is alone with an adult without a second adult present, whenever reasonably possible.

5.4 Mandatory Reporting: The Company complies with all mandatory reporting laws for suspected abuse or neglect.

5.5 Liability Limitation: Parent/Guardian acknowledges and agrees that the Company is not liable for the intentional criminal acts of third parties, including but not limited to molestation, abuse, or assault, and that any such acts are outside the scope of the Company's services.

6. PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

6.1 Ensure their child is prepared for pick-up and drop-off at the agreed location and time.

6.2 Provide accurate emergency contact and medical information.

6.3 Discuss personal safety rules with their child, including reporting any inappropriate conduct immediately.

7. INDEMNIFICATION

Parent/Guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Company from any and all claims, damages, losses, or expenses (including reasonable legal fees) arising from their child's participation in the transportation service, except where prohibited by law.

8. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State/Province of _____.

APPENDIX A - ABUSE PREVENTION POLICY

Purpose:

The safety and well-being of all passengers, especially minors, is the Company's top priority. This Policy outlines preventive measures and operational procedures.

Preventive Measures:

1. Background Checks: All drivers and staff undergo criminal background checks and driving record reviews in accordance with applicable law.
2. Training: Drivers receive training on child safety, appropriate conduct, and mandatory reporting obligations.
3. No One-on-One Policy: Reasonable efforts will be made to avoid situations where a child is alone with an

adult without another authorized adult present, except where operationally unavoidable.

4. Restricted Physical Contact: Physical contact is limited to what is necessary for safety (e.g., assisting with seatbelts).

5. Mandatory Reporting: Any suspicion of abuse or misconduct will be reported immediately to the appropriate authorities.

Limitations:

- The Company cannot guarantee that abuse, molestation, or misconduct will never occur despite preventive measures.
- No screening process or supervision method can eliminate all risks.
- Parent/Guardian releases the Company from liability for intentional criminal acts by third parties, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
